 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting American
- 5 Business from Foreign Adversaries Act of 2022".

1 SEC. 2. REGISTRATION OF AGENT.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 190 of title 28, United
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing new section:

5 "§ 5002. Registration of an agent for the service of 6 process on covered entities

7 "(a) IN GENERAL.—A covered entity conducting
8 business in the United States shall register with the De9 partment of Commerce not less than one agent residing
10 in the United States if the covered entity—

11 "(1) is organized under the laws of, or has its12 principal place of business in, a foreign country;

13 "(2) is traded in shares and such shares are
14 held in majority by any individual or group of indi15 viduals reside in a foreign country; or

"(3) is owned by individuals or other entities
who reside or are headquartered outside of the
United States and the majority of business earnings
of the covered entity are derived from commerce outside of the United States.

21 "(b) FILING.—A registration required under sub22 section (a) shall be filed with the Department of Com23 merce not later than 30 days after—

24 "(1) the date of enactment of this Act; or

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"(2) the departure of the previously registered
 agent from employment or contract with the covered
 entity.

4 "(c) PURPOSE OF REGISTERED AGENT.—

5 "(1) AVAILABILITY.—A covered entity shall en-6 sure that not less than one registered agent on 7 whom process may be served is available at the busi-8 ness address of the registered agent each day from 9 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the time zone of the business ad-10 dress, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal 11 holidays.

12 "(2) COMMUNICATION.—The registered agent 13 shall be required to be available to accept service of 14 process on behalf of the covered entity under which 15 the agent is registered by the means of any commu-16 nication included in the registration submitted to the 17 Department of Commerce.

18 "(d) COOPERATION.—A registered agent shall co19 operate in good faith with the United States Government
20 and representatives of other individuals and entities.

21 "(e) REQUIRED INFORMATION.—The registration
22 submitted to the Department of Commerce shall include
23 the following information:

24 "(1) The name of the covered entity registering25 an agent under this section.

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1 "(2) The name of the Chief Executive Officer, 2 President, Partner, Chairman, or other controlling individual of the covered entity. 3 "(3) The name of the individual who is being 4 5 registered as the agent for the service of process. 6 "(4) The business address of the covered entity registering an agent under this section. 7 8 "(5) The business address of the individual who 9 is being registered as the agent for the service of 10 process. 11 "(6) Contact information, including an email 12 address and phone number for the individual who is 13 being registered as the agent for the service of proc-14 ess. 15 ((7) The date on which the agent shall begin 16 to accept service of process under this section. 17 "(f) WEBSITE.—The information submitted to the Department of Commerce pursuant to this section shall 18 19 be made available on a publicly accessible database on the website of the Department of Commerce. 20 21 "(g) PERSONAL JURISDICTION.—A covered entity 22 that registers an agent under this section thereby consents 23 to the personal jurisdiction of the State or Federal courts 24 of the State in which the registered agent is located for 5

the purpose of any regulatory proceeding or civil action
 relating to such covered entity.

- 3 "(h) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
- 4 "(1) COVERED ENTITY.—The term 'covered en-5 tity' means—

6 "(A) a corporation, partnership, associa7 tion, organization, or other combination of per8 sons established for the purpose of commercial
9 activities; or

10 "(B) a trust or a fund established for the11 purpose of commercial activities.

12 "(2) DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.—The term
13 'Department of Commerce' means the United States
14 Department of Commerce.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
for chapter 190 of title 28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:

"5002. Registration of an agent for the service of process on covered entities.".
